Disturbing **Homeless Numbers**

Tonight's guest speaker was Jenny Sinclair the Incoming President of the Sunrise Rotary Club. Jenny is the Manager of EACH in NSW an organisation that has a \$75m budget with 250 workers seeking to care for many of the hurting in our community. Jenny spoke on HOMELESS YOUTH. There are 175-200 youth sleeping

rough in the Hastings each night. The head of the drug centre said he thought this was underestimated & he thought more like 400 kids sleeping rough in this area.

Over 105,000 men, women & children in Australia are homeless (ie. Sleeping rough or couch surfing). Mostly due to domestic & family violence.

Jenny told one harrowing story of a young man rejected & struggling in our community. She told another story of a young


man who has successfully gained an apprenticeship as a chef & is doing well despite some tragic beginnings.

She told the story 'homelessness' that many of us would rather not know about, with compassion & empathy & made a dour story that is blight on our Australian community into something positive. Thank you Jenny.
