


### Trish's Polio Immunisation Tour to India -January 2017

Trish went with two others, Alec Brown & Bobby-Jo Woods from Port Macquarie & joined a health team from 10 countries around the world in India They were involved in immunising 100s of children against polio in Agra in India. Trish showed some moving pictures of polio victims & the amazing job Rotary has done in countries like India in eradicating polio. Only three countries are polio affected - Pakistan, Afghanistan & Nigeria & getting people immunised in these countries is nigh impossible at present due to conflicts & religious blockages.
