Rotary Saves 650 Lives from Cancer

2017 will be the last year that District 9650 will be offering Bowelscan kits to the public. As well as introducing this program in this District we assisted Bowelscan programs in Alice Springs, Perth, East Gosford & Manningham in Victoria & supported other Rotary Districts.



Over the past thirty two years District 9650 Bowelscan kits have informed over 3000 patients they have polyps and extended the life of over 650 people who were detected with bowel cancer in our District through the kits.

Members of our Rotary club have given 1000s of hours manning Bowelscan Kit sales for one week each year for the past 32 years. We have enjoyed engaging with the public in such a worthwhile cause and have met several people who have told us that a Rotary Bowelscan Kit has resulted in them becoming aware of early onset of bowel cancer & they have been healed.



Terry Crossley's story

Our club Secretary, Terry Crossley has worked on the Bowelscan Kit Sales desk for many years. Each year Terry bought a kit. In 2006 his test showed a positive result of Stage 1 bowel cancer. This was only 12 months after his last test. Terry underwent a surgical procedure known as a right hemi colectomy which entailed removal and reconnection of

a section of bowel. Because it was caught early and had not progressed to any other organs, he did not require chemo or radiation and has been cancer-free since 2006.

Terry is very concerned Rotary will no longer be making these kits available. The Federal Government has introduced a National Bowel

Cancer Screening Program that will offer kits every second year for those aged between 50 & 74 by 2020. There is no way of detecting bowel cancer at Stage 1 without a colonoscopy or a test kit designed to test minute amounts of blood in the colon. Terry is concerned that this will not be often enough. In his case, if he had waited four more years before detection, his chances of survival would have fallen to 8% from 93%!!!!! Terry encourages every Rotarian & the public to continue to have annual checks. Not to do so could be at our peril.
