Rotary Visits Endeavour House

Tonight our club made a memorable visit to the Endeavour Mental Health Recovery Clubhouse. Another of Port Macquarie's 'well-kept' secrets!

Rob Moorehead the Club's Director shared with us the dream of Endeavour & after 13 years of fund-raising by the community the clubhouse is now open & treating many in our community who struggle with mental health issues. Yesterday, Rob & the staff counselled 43 people (including a woman whom Rob spent 6 hours) & today another 32 needed assistance.

We were treated to a delicious meal prepared by the clubhouse members & served by Big John, Scotty, Sarah & Christine.

Rob shared of the difficulty of on-going funding & the need for continuing support & also for sufferers to receive some adequate government funding for the illness. Rob thanked Rotary for our huge support of Endeavour & also Sam Openshaw & the Schizophrenia Assoc that has raised over

\$120,000 towards
Endeavour. Endeavour is
an amazing facility
working on the 'sharpend' of moderate &
severe mental illness.
Rob said stats show that
in a few years over 42%
of our community will be
suffering from some
form of mental illness.

Boyter's Lane - 10th Anniversary



Thank you to the Rotary Club of South West Rocks for inviting our members as their guests to a 10th anniversary of the Boyter's Lane Wetlands Project at Jerseyville, SWR.

Originally, the Club successfully applied for a \$40,000 Government grant to complete part of a larger Council plan to build playing fields and to protect surrounding wetlands. The Club built an artificial wetland to stop nutrient runoff into the Macleay River, planted thousands of trees, tested water, and eventually built a bird hide using timber from a 100 year old dairy shed already on the land. Although the playing fields have not yet been built, the Council continues with the environmental and educational component of the overall project planting more indigenous trees, building pathways, platforms and possibly more bird hides.
