'Mystery Man' Found

For months we have been searching for our Club's 1st founding President Allan Ryan (pictured below right). All searches were proving fruitless until we discovered a Charlie Allan Ryan.

Our Charter President was found. Apparently Allan was called Charlie Allan, but was known as Allan.

The following is an interesting bio of Allan from the Council records.

Allan Ryan - was born in 1901 in Hay NSW. He was a pharmacist, (his pharmacy was in Horton Street, the present site of Priceline Pharmacy) a newsagent & landowner/ developer.

He married Freda Isabel Aynsley in 1932 in Sydney. They had one son (name unknown) Allan was Mayor of Port Macquarie 1945-47 & 1949. He died on 5th June 1966 at his home in Killara, Sydney,

aged 65.
