Now the mystery! The gong was presented to our club by the Rotary Club of Taree's President Frank Hole at the Charter night on May 22nd 1948. However on reading the inscription carved into the gong it states the gong was presented on 22nd April 1948! Now - was this a mistake by the person inscribing the gong or was our club originally to be chartered on the April 22nd date?

This is the mystery - which date? The club WAS chartered on May 22nd, but how come the date April 22nd is inscribed on the gong we have had in the club & used almost every week for the past 70 years????? - Kerry Medway
