

Prior to Sunday 9th, Lorryl is looking for help to pick up the plants. One nursery is at Wauchope – the second lot comes from The Macleay Nursery 113 Crescent Head Road, Kempsey. If you can help, please contact Lorryl.

Lorryl has said that there are a total of 45 plants to be planted as well as painting the gazebo. Just in case you don't think you will have anything to do if you turn up, she has provided the following list of jobs:

Paint Gazebo (need ladders and a paint brush)

Plant 15 Lime Toughs in top garden (Spade large and small)

Plant Katie Bell Lomandras between the trees as windbreak

Plant 16 Corea Albas in middle tier of garden

Remove the native lasiandra in bottom tier(fork and clippers/saw)

Refurbish the soil in that garden — then rest garden for two weeks

Clip pigface in front garden

Weed, tidy up other parts of garden including dead heading

Tidy up plants around the Rotary Sign

Pressure hose all the brickwork (later in year)




