District Governor Lorraine Coffey issued a challenge to Rotary—'start again & this time be inclusive'. After watching an inspirational DVD clip by RI President Barry Rassin on BE THE INSPIRATION, Lorraine gave her challenge.

She reminded us that the average age of Rotarians in District 9650 is 72 (Paul Harris was only 36 when he was inspired to start Rotary). Years ago our Rotary Clubs had much younger members, but over the years we got old!

Lorraine spoke about the Hastings Rotaract Club & how they are being included in District activities & some Rotaractors were invited to the Aust/NZ

Conference in Tasmania a few weeks back. Let's 'be inspired' with fresh vision & new ideas.

Lorraine also spoke on Rotary's involvement in drought relief. RAWCS & Channel 9 raised

\$10.2million & this was given to the Farmer's Federation to distribute. City Rotary Clubs have supported country Rotary & sponsored & encouraged them in supporting drought stricken farmers & families & communities.

Lorraine's partner Dennis Coffety shared his **Partner's Project**, raising \$36,000 for a 3 year **Research Scholarship into Motor Neurone Disease**.




