

A magnificent Rotary Float featured in the 1968 Carnival of the Pines with Helen Radley (Parks). Helen worked for Rotarian Tom Rissell, a local businessman & member of the PMQ Rotary Club from 1967-78. The truck used for the Rotary float was owned by legendary Rotarian Athol Platt. (Rotarian 1954-78) The floral decorations were spectacular, but the truck driver Gary (Storky) Wincote was unable to see where he was going & as the float travelled down the streets, Storky was being directed by Helen from atop the float.
