Huuuuuge Rotary - RAWCS support for Nepal

Loveday The Rotary Club of Port Macquarie is supporting A4WH and its Director Dr Ray Hodgson in helping to fund the building of a Mums and Babies hospital in the Dolakha region of Nepal by way of a RAWCS project.

District 9650 have put together a Global Grant to purchase the equipment for that hospital. The Rotary Club of Dhulikhel is partnering us in this venture.

We have gained support from other Districts in the USA and Iceland who have pledged their District Designated Funds to help support the funding of this equipment.

The cost of the equipment needed is USD 262,743.00. Rotary is contributing USD\$140,161.00 and the Rotary Foundation is contributing \$122,582.00 from the World Fund. The Global Grant is just waiting for the District Foundation Chair from Nepal to Authorise his bit and it will then be submitted to Rotary in Evanston to approve the application. If we are successful this will be the largest Global Grant application submitted by District 9650, and one of the largest in Australia.
