At this event, Dick and Pip Smith were present to hand over a second cheque for \$1million.

Dick said "Pip and I were delighted with the work done by Rotary following our last major donation in



2016. We like the idea of the Dollar - for - Dollar Grants so much that we decided to make another \$1million donation to Rotary on the same basis". RAWCS Chairman, John McClaren accepted the cheque on behalf of RAWCS.

President Bob thanked Dick and Pip on behalf of the hundreds of people who have benefited from the first donation. He said that whilst Drought Relief would be a major focus for RABS funds there are so many other people in our communities in need of help and these funds will be used to assist those who most need it.
