Yesterday I spent about 4 hours with Mark Livermore as the first of the 3 B-doubles unloaded the hay Rotary paid for. This will be distributed to dairy farmers in the Hastings & Manning areas. I just wish I could get enough to give some to more people. Up till now, our Rotary District has distributed about \$1.7M. I will continue to source hay, but need donations.
