We heard last Wednesday that the boys had an inspiring time at Rymarine.

So what is it?

In a nutshell - it is a program run by Rotary for youth

interested in marine science or related fields. The Coffs Daybreak R/C sponsor this program each year with 21 year 9-11 students invited. The residential program commences on Thursday at 5pm & runs until Sunday at 1pm.

The young people stayed at the Australian Youth Hostel. Input was received from the Australian Marine Science Centre, Southern Cross University, Solitary Island Marine Park Authority, NSW Water Police, C/H Dive Centre, Solitary Island Underwater Research Group, Customs, Marine Rescue, the Fisherman's Co-op, Dolphin Marine Magic, National Parks & Lifeguard NSW.


It was an amazing insight for the boys & both were inspired to pursue marine science or the water Police as career options.




Winner of the PDG Barrie Titcume (1971-72) Trophy for best club bulletin in 2018-2019 in Rotary District 9650, Australia.

Col Kelahar -Life Behind Bars

Our Melbourne Cup feature night wasn't able to happen, so Neil Porter brought in one of his golfing partners Col Kelaher. Col has worked in the NSW Prison system for over 30 years. He retired in 2014 as Assistant Commissioner Northern Region. He was in charge of prisons from Windsor to the Queensland border.



about such characters as Ivan Milat, the Murphy brothers who murdered Anita Coby and several other infamous prisoners. Some of Col's stories were shocking, but he mixed them with some laconic humour.

Col designed Goulburn's Super Max Prison, he worked at Junee's privately owned prison. He had some great insights into the NSW prison system.

One story Col told was when he was in charge at Goulburn & they had four murders in Number 7 section. The Prison's Commissioner Ron Woodham called as Col had just been attending to one of the victims & answered the phone covered in blood. The Commissioner let it be known in colourful language he wanted no more deaths in Section 7 or else he

would come down & run the gaol himself!!!! After Col got off the phone, one of the prison guards said what will we do? Col said, "Go out and change the numbers on the Prison sections"!!!!


