

Update from the Club Board

Dear Members,

The Board met on Wednesday and discussed the many issues regarding the ongoing management of the Club. The following decisions were taken:

1. The Club will not meet during April.

2. The Board will meet again on 22nd April, 2020 to review the situation at that time.

3. The Board will meet on 22nd April by way of Zoom meeting. The Club will register with Zoom and pay any required fees.

3. Should the Club be unable to meet as normal at Panthers after 22nd April then it is proposed that each Wednesday we have a Zoom meeting with all members.
