Debbies Dunnies Update In Nepal

Following the devastating earthquakes in Nepal in 2015 (7.8 on Richter scale - 5,057 people killed, over 8,000 people in Nepal injured) DGE Debbie Loveday received a request from the Rotary Club of Dhulkhell in District 3292 to construct toilets in a village to ease serious sanitary problems.



The Rotary Club of Port Macquarie working with the R/C of Dhulkhell in Nepal have constructed 25 new toilets at a cost of \$250 (AUD) each toilet. (There are still 35 more toilets to be built & funds are being sought for these).

A request for 35 more toilets at DadaGaw-Panchkhal

The R/C of Dhulkhell has requested the need to replace 60 toilets in this locality. Discussions with the local villagers has made the local Rotarians aware that these new toilets can be built using locals whilst teaching them the skills needed to build and maintain the toilets in the future. A simple pan construction with septic tank (see diagram above) using a water harvesting system will enable the people to have a private clean area to toilet. This



in turn will discourage open defecation and together with a hand-washing program will improve the locals health and quality of life.

Locals will be employed and be able to use their new skills to instruct others. It is believed that working with the local R/C this is a sustainable program to ensure longevity and achieve the locals goals. Each toilet costs \$250 (AUD).
