"Our Club has been discussing this STEM/ Robotics Project since last September and with the help of a District Designated Grant (DDF) commenced the first STEM/ Robotics Hub over Christmas. We then ran aground with the arrival of the Coronavirus and disappointingly were not even able to attend the opening. In the meantime Incoming Westport R/C President Heather Mayne applied for a Community Grant. (The success of this application for a grant will be known by November 2020). This joint Westport and Rotary Club of Port Macquarie project is now back on track and there is a great amount of enthusiasm all round.

Two specialist "grant writers" Fred O'Toole Port Macquarie Club and Rick Eller of Westport Club will work with a very small team and partner with Hastings Secondary College to try to attract as many further grants as possible during the 20/21 year. BEST OF LUCK TO THE GRANT WRITERS!

In the meantime there is a rumour that later in the year our club's Vocational Committee led by Neil Porter will be taking us to the school to have a look at the Robotics porogram and maybe meet some of the students who love these new "toys". "


