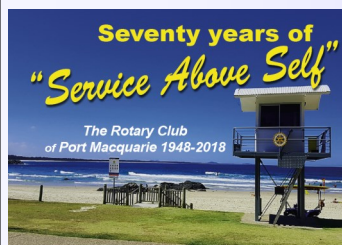
WHO AM I or WHAT AM I? Limerick quiz.
