

Fred O'Toole updates the Ocean Tidal Pool

Fred gave an interesting update on the progress of the Ocean Tidal Pool. Two of our club members Fred & Geoff Slack are on the planning committee for the pool & have been working feverishly over the past 4 years to make this pool happen.

A survey was taken with 18,000 signatures (the biggest survey ever) in favour of the pool. The NSW Govt gave \$50,000 towards a feasibility study & many facts were revealed & the pool cleared all hindrances. The capital cost of the pool is estimated at 3 million + 8the maintenance costs p/a is estimated at

\$78,000. Sites for the pool were investigated at Town, Oxley, Flynns & Lighthouse Beaches. The most favourable site was found to be on the northern end of Oxley Beach.

The Federal Govt has granted \$4.5 million towards the construction costs of the new pool with \$1.5 allocated for this year. Work is expected to begin before the end of the year. The new pool will feature an 8-lane Olympic size main pool, plus pools for children & disabled. Disabled parking & a toilet block,

are to be built. Council is considering a major survey of the Oxley Beach area looking at parking, etc. Well done Fred & Geoff & team.
