#### **Rotary Solar Case**

Tonights guest speaker was Darcy Geale (accompanied by his wife Helen) from the R/C of Salamandar Bay (Nelson Bay). Darcy gave a passionate presentation of an invention he has been working on to assist third world countries with the need for light

& power.

The Rotary Solar Case is a compact high power battery bank designed to provide light & power in remote health centres. The need for good lighting is essential for safe birthing (as opposed to kerosene lamps & torches often having to be used). Darcy has created three units, two of which have been sent to New Guinea for testing. Working with Durst Industries these units could be made for about \$1500 (reducing down to \$1000 ea if mass production of 100 units could be produced). The US models cost

The program is about 2 years behind schedule due to Covid restrictions.

Darcy is continuing to work on the unit & hopes it may also assist Dr Ray Hodgson's work in Nepal.
