Antiquarian Gold Mine

Our Second-hand Book Shop contains a treasure trove of old & Antiquarian books.

As well as the \$3-00 sales of most of our books some old & rare books have been set-aside for special sales. Kerry Medway checks these books out

on various antiquarian book web-sites such as E-Bay, Biblio-file, etc. When a book's value is estimated, Kerry cuts the recommended sale price in half,

wraps the book in a plastic sleeve & labels it (see samples on right) and it is placed on a special shelf in the bookshop for sale.

At present we have 94 Antiquarian books for sale, valued at -\$2145-00.

Valda Sturrock also takes some books she considers to be valuable, they could be old and rare or just something people might be willing to pay more than \$3/4-00 for. She offers them for sale on E-Bay. Last year we sold over \$4000 worth of books but E-Bay & postage charges are cutting our profit margins. Some special books we have sold were - "Dr Ox's Experiment and Other Stories" by Jules Verne, sold to someone in the US for \$360-00. Another was "The Baburnama" sold to a buyer from Norway for \$230-00. We also auctioned on E-Bay a set of Ginger Meggs comiss.

Meanwhile our Saturday morning bookshop continues to do well. Sales on Saturday 7th August were \$596-00 (the shop has been closed for the past two Saturdays during lock-down). Valda and Bob and several club members help out each Saturday & on Sundays during public holidays and do an amazing job in raising funds for our club & the community. We now have a large base of regular customers, some who come in to the shop every Saturday. Our cutest customer is a 4 year old girl who brings her Mum and Dad in every week

and spends \$1-50 which she carefully takes from her pink handbag.

Tonight's speaker via **ZOOM was Ashleigh**

Hickman from Gloucester who is District 9650 RAM (Rotarians Against Malaria) Chair.



Ashleigh gave us some disturbing facts & figures about malaria and RAMs fight to combat it in over 100 countries around the world. Each year there are 228million cases with 40,500

deaths. 67% of the deaths are children aged under 5.

Rotary's RAMs (which is part of RAWCS) main attack is the distribution of mosquito bed nets impregnated with insecticide placed over sleeping beds. The female mosquito is the malaria spreader and is very active in early mornings and in the evenings. Bed nets, if properly impregnated will last for 3 years. Also

promoting IRTS spraying & providing vaccinations & medicine. The need to combat malaria is serious and RAMs hopes Rotary International will adopt the attack against malaria as the next major project when polio is under control.
