

Underwater Photographer & Diver Mark Spencer

Was our guest speaker via Zoom tonight. Mark is a Rotarian & dental surgeon in Coffs Harbour with a passion for underwater exploration and photography.

In 1998 Mark led an expedition to the Dardanelle Strait near Turkey & the site of Gallipolli in WW1 to dive to the wreck of Australia's second submarine AE2 which was scuttled in 1915. Mark showed us some remarkable pictures of the submarine (pictured below at the dock).



In 1996 Mark and his wife travelled to an island off Mexico and dived with mantra rays. Mark showed us some amazing photos of swimming with and riding these gigantic rays. This adventure was featured in the National Geographic magazine. This led to Mark being invited to meet a young boy in Sydney Hospital dying from a rare disease who had adopted the mantra ray as his special animal. When Mark visited him in the hospital he had mantra ray blankets and was fascinated by Mark's photos and stories. Sadly, the boy died the next day.



Thanks Mark for a great presentation.


Lorryl's Inspirational Quote of the Week
