John has been a Board Director of our club and regular supporter of our club's monthly shift for meals-on-wheels. He and Mary have been on Rotary Friendship



Left - John delivering Meals-on-Wheels







### **Insight into PROBUS**


PROBUS stands for Clubs for Retired Professional & Business Persons, former Executives and Others.
