

Our Rotary club is preparing for an exciting environmental program to preserve our marine life.

The program commences with an invitation to Rotarians, surf club members and the community to be held at PMQ Surf Club at Flynns Beach on 22nd October with Chantelle Doyle and her partner Mark

Rapley the keynote speakers. That evening will lead into the BioBlitz extended weekend to be held on 12th, 13th, 14th and 15th May 2023 involving Marine ecologists, university students, school students, lifesavers, Rotarians and other volunteers including

Our club's BioBlitz team is headed by Dr Ted Giblin (pictured) and our club's Vocational Director Diana Gammon with volunteer Barbara Smith from the Roving Trainer Computer

Consultancy.

The BioBlitz weekend event will involve citizen science to record all species on a prescribed local transect from pelagic to offshore to shoreline to dune habitats. Including plants, animals, birds and marine life. There will be a No.1 BioBlitz recorder and the results of the weekend will go to a national database. It is intended that this will be an annual Port Macquarie event promoted by the Port Macquarie Rotary Club and other environmentalists. Our club contributed \$1000 as a starter grant to cover expenses for planning BioBlitz.

It is also planned that a SUSTAINABLE SEAFOOD COMPETITION will be held involving local restaurants, commencing in 2023.

A round-table time of sharing about the **club's current program format**.


