# Port Macquarie Rotary MARINE Shelly Beach, Port Macquarie **BIO BLITZ**

Tonight Ted Giblin gave us an update on the Bio-Blitz to be held at Shelly Beach on 12-13 May. Friday 12th will be for schoolchildren with more than 180 students expected. Saturday 13th will be open for families and the general community.

Bio Blitz has twin aims - to collect data and involve the community. It's the first time a B/B has been held in Port Macquarie and Ted & the team hope it may become a regular event, so that data can be collected & compared to previous years to give us an insight on the state of health of our marine life on the east coast of Australia.

Ted encouraged all to get a special app on our phones called I NATURALIST. When seeing an object that you wish to identify, take a photo & submit it to the app & all-sorts of information about the marine object will be revealed.

Six environmental experts will be coming to Port Macquarie for the weekend and will spearhead the Bio Blitz discoveries and investigations.

Bio-Blitz is a scientific study of the health and biodiversity of the place in which we live. This first year will form a baseline of our Port Macquarie environment. Over the years with further Bio-Blitz s, it is hoped we can learn about the health of our marine environment. All information will be stored as data on a national database called the Atlas of Living Australia.

As well, there will be several display tents, including a Shark display trailer that already has attracted much interest, especially from the school students.
