Wednesday 9 th August saw us in the Glasshouse Forecourt at the Community Awareness Day organised by the Port Macquarie Hastings Homelessness Collective. We ran the Fill a Tent campaign on the day and received a huge amount of donations of clothes, toiletries, and camping equipment. This was such a huge success that it will become an annual feature.

On Thursday 10 August, we held a special event at "Our Place" for our regular



visitors. There was live music, free haircuts, and a delicious free curry lunch as well as the usual things on offer such as free clothes, pantry items, legal support, mental health support, free BBV testing, flu shots, showers, laundry facility, and Centrelink.
