

Treasurer Bob Cleland told the club that we have made \$74,000 from our fundraising, mostly from sales via the bookshop & the Giant Booksale.

Also Bob shared there was an amount of \$3140 that had been set-aside for the purchase of Community Defibrillators via the Charles Sturt University. The syudent body stated that there was no need for more defibrillators and asked if a scholarship could be set-up to assist paramedic students. The club has set aside \$2000 for \$500 scholarships & the left-over moneys will be used for this scholarship to continue annually with our club to stump-up the moneys to \$2000 each year.

Following the AGM Bob Cleland led us through the Rotary 9660 Youth


Protection Information. All members are asked to comply with a Working With Children certification. This is a club legal thing to comply with our club insurance. Bob will be chasing up those who we
