## Dr Ted, a Twitcher & a Great Rotarian

Sadly on Friday 9th February, Dr Ted Giblin died.

Ted had a great love for his wife & family & also loved bird watching. For us Ted was a great Rotarian for 33 years.

He first joined the R/C of Darwin North 1983-2001 & then joined the Letchworth Garden R/C in the UK from 2001-2004. On his arrival in Port Macquarie, Ted joined the Port Macquarie R/C in 2011 where he served with distinction until his death on the 9th February 2024.

Ted was President of the Darwin North R/C in 1993. He was awarded a Paul Harris Fellowship in 1994. At the PMQ R/C he

was President in 2013/14 & was on the District Rotary Committee for Australian Rotary Health.

Ted instigated the Rotary Emergency Services Volunteer of the Year Award, which ran for several years & saw some outstanding Life Savers, SES (State Emergency Service) &

RFS (Rural Fire Service) volunteers being honoured. He introduced a Rotary Passport for Rotarians travelling overseas & was also a driving force

in the weekly International Toast which was proclaimed at each Rotary meeting & a card sent to the club overseas. We received some lovely replies from R/Cs around the world.

Ted was one of the driving forces for the BIO BLITZ event at Shelley Beach last year which saw the recording of environmental impacts on the beach & surrounding rain

Ted is survived by his wife Robbie & five children.

Ted's funeral service will be @ 10am on Tuesday 20th February @ Innes Gardens, Philip Charley Drive.

The girls gave an interesting presentation re. the introduction for seniors of DIGITAL TRANSFORMATION a program that they are hoping to introduce for GV residents to take them on virtual reality trips to Africa, & around the world.
