


Seventy Five Years of Rotary - Service Above Self

Thanks to Bob Cleland for sending these Rotarian's photos & Rotary history to the District Secretary for display at the conference.




Dr Ted Giblin, President 2013/14 presenting the Rotary Emergency Services Award to the President of the Port Macquariue Surf Life Saving Association.


Stav in the Know!
