Today marks a significant milestone for Port Macquarie Rotary Lodge!

We're thrilled to announce that the Board has officially signed a construction contract with Kevin Butterworth of Butterworth Building Construction

for the \$1.4 million expansion to the Lodge! This expansion will add 12 extra rooms, bringing us to 48 rooms, and further increasing capacity to provide affordable accommodation for Port Macquarie Base Hospital patients, their families, Mid North Coast Cancer Institute patients and visiting medical staff.

Thanks to the support of Port Macquarie MP Leslie Williams, the project received a generous \$510,000 NSW Government Grant last year. This support will ensure the expansion project moves forward smoothly and efficiently.

Dear Rotarians & Friends,

Thank you so very much for your contribution towards the success of our Annual Book Sale. More than 40 people pitched-in to help get the books into Panthers, onto tables and then to keep it all in order so that book lovers could find what they were after. Other helpers welcomed customers and manned the checkout tables. Then there was the clean-up crew.

The joy that so many people get from reading would almost make this worthwhile without taking into account the funds raised. I estimate that we found new homes for some 12,000 books over the three days.

Our income was 22% higher than last year, reaching \$29,500 which certainly exceeded our expectations and will allow us to provide even more help to many within our community.

Once again thank you, we couldn't have done this without you and a special thank you to the many non-Rotarians who contributed their time and energy to make this such a success.
