CSUSPA Scholarships

Our Club has a history of supporting the Charles Sturt University student paramedics. From assistance in organising a student ball, to purchasing defibrillators and assisting students with a contribution to their placement expenses. Students have no say in where their placement will take place and this year placements have ranged from the Sydney CBD, Western Sydney, Orange, Albury and the Central Coast. Students are expected to meet their own travel and accommodation costs and these can be quite substantial.

For the past two years our club has assisted 8 students by awarding 4 grants of \$500 each to help defray these expensive placements. 14 students applied for the grants this year and their application forms contained information on their academic performance, their contribution to the community and need for assistance. Bob and Neil assessed all applications and made 2 recommendations and in June met with the students to announce the successful applicants.
