Work and Stay Settlement Program

Recently, our Club was contacted by Work+ Stay, a Sydney based organisation that finds jobs for overseas professionals who want to work in regional Australia.

Work+ Stay advised that they were looking for a community partner, who they could contract a fee for service to provide:

- Community welcome + orientation to migrant infrastructure workers successfully placed with Port Macquarie Hastings Regional Council.
- Community connections for the newcomer worker and their family to feel a sense of inclusion and become functional in their new community.

Work+Stay have 22 of these Community Welcome Partnerships across regional NSW, QLD and VIC, and have partnered successfully with other Rotary Clubs in NSW.

Our first newcomer is Dinusha Prabath a Sri Lankan Civil Engineer who has found employment with the local council.

Dinusha is a married man and has spent the past 14 years working in Dubai. His wife (a lecturer in Environmental Science) and son will be joining him in early August.

The Club's commitment is to meet with Dinusha once a week for the first 4 weeks of his arrival and show him the locations of services that he and his family will need. Those include, health, medical, retail, recreational, education and tourist sites.

To date Bob Cleland, Rob Dalla Costa and Neil Porter have held a Zoom meeting and two in-person meetings with Dinusha. The Club will produce weekly progress reports for Work+Stay and at the end of the four- week program, the plan is for Dinusha and his family to have made community connections, have a sense of inclusion and have a friendly face to go to for information and assistance.

The Club will receive \$600 from Work and Stay at the conclusion of the program.


