Gail Davis: A Journey from City Life to Country Living



On Monday night, Gail Davis delivered an engaging presentation, taking us on a nostalgic journey through her transition from city living to the rugged charm of country life. With her husband lan, Gail embarked on an adventure that began in 2015 with the purchase of 200 sheep on 50 acres at Old Theomont.

Her story, peppered with humour and reflection, revealed the steep learning curve of becoming a sheep owner. From managing four cheeky rams who delighted in escaping the property in search of "the girls," to the joys (and challenges) of their first shearing in August 2016, Gail brought the trials and triumphs of life on the land vividly to life.

One of the standout moments of their journey was spinning their first wool. Gail shared the fascinating fact that wool fibre measures just 17 microns—remarkably fine compared to a human hair at 80 microns! This delicate transformation from fleece to yarn marked a significant milestone in their rural adventure.

By 2018, Gail and lan decided to leave the sheep business, but the lessons and memories they gained will stay with them forever. Gail's presentation reminded us all of the resilience, resourcefulness, and humour required to embrace change and tackle new challenges.

We thank Gail for sharing her inspiring journey and offering us a glimpse into the unpredictable yet rewarding life of going "bush."
